It's the time of the year when we make plans to head to one of the most impacting conferences that is available to teenagers today! We always expect Dare2Share to be huge in the development of our students, and it looks like this year is not going to disappoint. To the right, is a description of this year's theme.

These conferences work by helping students to be better established in their faith, challenging them to set apart Christ as their Lord, and helping them to be better prepared to give a defense for the hope that they have in Christ. Here are the details for our participation in this special weekend. Please read these details carefully as you will want to be fully aware of them. The registration opportunity begins soon!

- This conference is open to students in grades 7th -12th.
- The dates of our trip are **Friday, Feb. 25th – Sunday, Feb. 27th** (students will have to miss school on Feb 25th in order to go)
- We will be meeting at the church at 6 AM on Friday and returning around 4:30 PM on Sunday.
- The total cost is **\$65** per student with a \$30 non-refundable deposit required with the registration.
- The first day that students are able to register is **Sunday, Jan 23rd**. Registrations and deposits may be given to Mrs. Urcelay or dropped in the registration boxes in the church lobby.
- The last day that students may register is **Sunday, Feb 7th**, but the trip may fill up before then!
- Currently, we only have **22** student tickets available.
- All students registering after the **22nd** student will be put on a waiting list until we make sure we can get more tickets. We will only be taking a **maximum of 27 students** unless we have an additional parent volunteer to drive.
- Each registered student can expect to receive further information (i.e. packing list, Dare 2 Share waiver, etc.)

As our InnerChange Students prepare for this challenging conference, I am asking that you commit to praying for us! Pray for the students to be prepared to take the message they receive, allow themselves to be set ablaze for Christ, and spread that fire to others in their lives by sharing the gospel with them.
